



CONGRESSIONAL SEMINAR LEGACY SCHOLARS

Legacies* are welcome to participate in the NSCDA Congressional Seminar. Legacies are ineligible for the Congressional Seminar scholarships but may attend the Seminar at their own expense.

Legacy registration process, forms, fees, and instructions for submission.

- **Process:** Legacies must register by **March 1** to reserve a space in the Congressional Seminar. Registrations received later than March 1 will be accepted on a space-available basis.

Registration Form: Legacies complete the Legacy Scholars registration form posted on the Student Resources section of the [NSCDA website](#). Legacy registrants submit their forms directly to the National Essay Consultant. If a legacy submits his/her registration to a local or Corporate Society Dame, the form will necessarily be forwarded to the National Essay Consultant.

- **Recommended Preparation:** The Legacy Scholar is encouraged to study the assigned essay topic intently to be able to participate fully in discussions in the Seminar.
- **Legacy Fees:** Fees for the Congressional Seminar tuition are due by **March 15**, payable to: “NSCDA”
