### **Biography:**

Ingrid was the daughter of Olof Philipsson, a Finn who arrived with his family on the Mercurius in 1656.

She married Eric Millica, a Swede, and had eight children: Anna, Anders, Olof. Eric. John, Helena or Ella, Catharine and Stephen.

Several records also show Mullica as the spelling of the surname. It can be found in several place names in New Jersey. The Mullica House, circa 1704, in Mullica Hill, NJ has been placed on the National Register of Historic Places by the United States Department of the Interior.
